

THE FOOTBALL LEAGUE CUP 1974-75

If some critics' condemnation of Aston Villa's 1975 League Cup win as being 'the worst-ever Wembley final' was somewhat harsh, the competition certainly suffered from the unusual eclipse of First Division contenders. Not even in its formative years had the tournament produced such a freak set of results that not one semi-finalist came from the First Division.

Second Division sides showed a remarkable domination over their more illustrious opponents. Southampton, for example, emerged from a trough in their League form to slaughter Derby County by five goals in the second round, though in Channon, who claimed a hat-trick, and Osgood, another scorer, they possessed players of the very highest calibre. Manchester United, too, recaptured an appetite for First Division opposition which surely would have saved their top-grade status if it had appeared a year earlier. In front of a frenzied 55,000 crowd, a Gerry Daly penalty defeated Manchester City in the third round, a prelude to a fine tie in which Burnley led twice before United, inspired by Macari's initiative, won through. In the fifth round they displayed sufficient resilience at Ayresome Park to earn a draw before adding a third impressive scalp with a three-goal win over Middlesbrough in the replay.

Norwich City, losing finalists two years earlier, proved too strong for Sheffield United of the higher echelons, a brace of goals by young reserve Steve Goodwin settling the replay at Carrow Road. On the same ground in the next round they were held by title challengers Ipswich in a red-blooded East Anglian derby, but the theme of the whole competition was epitomised by the result of the replay - the Second Division side winning with two goals from Miller. An ironic touch, for Miller had been an Ipswich player a matter of weeks earlier.

On their way to the semi-finals, Aston Villa accounted for a succession of Third and Fourth Division sides, but they, too, created one significant upset. Their interest in the competition had waned considerably when Everton shared two goals at Villa Park, but again a replay reflected the paradox of the competition, Villa winning comfortably at Goodison with goals from Morgan, Carrodus, and Graydon.

But no team created more upsets than Chester, the club with historically the worst record in the League; the only one of ninety-two never to have been promoted. But manager Ken Roberts and coach Brian Green had moulded a squad invincible at their compact Sealand Road stadium. Walsall, soon to perform their own giant-killings in the FA Cup, were the first to fall, followed by Second Division contenders Blackpool and Bobby Charlton's Preston. Then the real heads started to roll.

In round four, two goals from a bandit called James and another from the ex-Liverpool defender Storton produced a wholly merited and completely decisive victory over Leeds United. And it was James again who robbed the rich of Newcastle United after Chester's proud defence had earned a goalless draw; so the Fourth Division had a semi-final representative.

But in the first leg the Aston Villa attack did not find the Chester rearguard so impregnable, and both McDonald and Graydon scored. The home side countered through Owen and Moore. With Leonard putting Villa two goals ahead in the second leg Chester's Wembley dreams appeared to have evaporated only for Mason and James to spur a revival. But Leonard, the game's most influential attacker, created a final goal for Little, and even gallant Chester could find no further riposte.

Meanwhile, Manchester United and Norwich were similarly tightly locked in struggle. After Powell had eased Norwich into the lead at Old Trafford, Macari's sixth and seventh goals in the competition tilted the advantage to United, before an atrocious error from a back-pass enabled the much-taunted Ted MacDougall, never a success in Manchester, to send Norwich back to Carrow Road on level terms. There, though United showed the more composure for long stretches of play, a scrambled goal by Suggett was the difference between the two sides.

If there was irony in the part played by MacDougall in the downfall of one of his former clubs, there was considerably more in the pairing of Norwich and Villa in the final. For example, it provided a third successive opportunity for Ron Saunders to manage a League Cup winning side. One year ago he had failed with Manchester City; two years ago his Norwich side had gone down to Tottenham Hotspur. Now, in his

first year with the Birmingham club, he had a chance to prove himself a winner against one of his old clubs.

And he certainly had sufficient incentive to do so. Saunders' successor at Carrow Road, John Bond, had spoken out harshly about the standard of the team bequeathed to him by his predecessor; indeed such had been Bond's reconstructing that only Keelan, Forbes, and Stringer of Saunders' Wembley side remained. There was irony, too, for Villa's midfield player Frank Carrodus; in the 1970 final he had been 13th man for Manchester City; in 1974 he had worn number 12 for the same club without getting into Wembley action; now he was selected to wear number eleven for Villa.

Both sides overcame pre-match injury and illness scares to enter the fray at full strength, though Norwich's Machin was to aggravate a thigh injury with his very first kick in a first half in which neither side truly overcame the pressures of the occasion. If Villa were the more settled at the outset, with Little of the astute running and elusive skills their most authoritative player, Norwich earned their share of the play towards the interval with Morris and Suggett directing the midfield traffic.

Neither goalkeeper was in serious difficulty during the opening forty-five minutes, yet so badly did Norwich fall away in the second period that Keelan had little respite while Cumbers whiled away his time fielding back passes. So magnificently did Keelan respond to this pressure that for a long time it seemed that disjointed Norwich would scramble away to a replay they hardly merited.

First, with a spectacular leap, Keelan turned over a header from Hamilton; then a brave save from Little after Graydon and Carrodus had knifed through the Norwich defence, followed by stretch of his foot to divert a Carrodus drive. And when he was beaten, by Hamilton's rasping left-footer, the ball ended in the side-netting.

But the game's critical moment came just ten minutes from time. Keelan had been forced to yet another save, from Robson, when for once his judgement proved faulty as he ventured off his line to meet Hamilton's corner. Nicholl had timed his movements to perfection and his strong header was bound for the far corner until Machin's grasping hands turned the ball around the post.

Keelan's brilliant agility gave one more twist to the drama, as plunging to his right he pushed Graydon's powerful penalty on to the post. But the rebound fell perfectly for the Villa leading scorer and this time even Keelan was helpless as Graydon exultantly swept the ball home. Norwich, hopelessly out of rhythm, desperately created one half chance in the remaining minutes, but Miller's final shot encapsulated Norwich's day, sailing harmlessly over the bar.
