

THE FOOTBALL LEAGUE CUP 1975-76

Mere facts and figures can be a poor substitute for the truth. In 100 years' time, all the records will reveal of the 1976 League Cup final at Wembley was that Manchester City scored most goals and thus took the trophy and the spin-off prize of a UEFA Cup place in 1976-77. But what of the real stars of this outstandingly entertaining February afternoon - the 'black and white army' of Newcastle fans? They do not deserve to be forgotten by history.

Throughout the competition the contribution of the Geordie hordes had been significant; so marked was the effect of their unrelenting support that fewer and fewer sides began to fancy any fixture that involved a trip to St James. The Newcastle team with the constant prowling menace of Macdonald and Gowling, was formidable, not among the highest-ranked, but with that crowd at their backs they were to look invincible at times. As the week of the final began, with four and then six of the Newcastle team afflicted by colds and 'flu, it became obvious that Newcastle were going to need all the help they could muster if they were to withstand the assault of a better-balanced and clearly more skilled Manchester City side.

That support was instantly forthcoming. Long before the kick-off the noise of the 'black and white' brigade filled the stadium with sound and emotion. City's own 'chorus' was made to look so miserable by comparison that it was hard to believe each club had an equal ticket allocation.

Newcastle players seemed to be almost visibly thrown into the match by the volume of noise, and certainly the first quarter-hour belonged to them. Despite the presence of defence of Watson and Doyle, Oakes and Booth - tall men all - City had the more appalling problems, trying to turn away the centres with which Newcastle teased them.

Yet City scored first. Hartford's clever free kick was knocked back across goal. Doyle and young Barnes ran into score at the far post with a mid-air volley that took every ounce of his spring and agility to control. There was a pause, time perhaps to count slowly to 20, then Newcastle's bubbling mass was back in full song.

Kennedy won a good tackle on the left, thence to Craig, on to Cassidy. Macdonald took the ball driven in from the right and laid it adroitly for Gowling to equalise. Before even turning to fall upon each other, the makers and takers of this goal looked first to 'their' terraces as though to say 'thanks'. Erratic by comparison with their cool rivals, Newcastle thus came to half-time level, though Tueart, for City, and Macdonald, for Newcastle, walked to the tunnel cursing the courage of the goalkeepers who had thwarted them equally in the seconds before half time.

Tueart was not made to wait long for revenge. Seconds only after the interval scored a goal of indelible novelty. He'd had one shot from the kick-off, and was wandering morosely along in its wake when Donachie crossed from the left. Both headed back into the centre and Tueart - a Geordie himself - scored with a bicycle kick.

The applause for that glorious goal came dinning down from *all* parts of the ground but it was to be a long while before much else happened worth a shout. Manchester City, with Hartford taking from Watson and Doyle and feeding his wings, had control of the game; Newcastle, tiring by the minute, could neither match this command, nor overcome it. And so the game might have drifted to anti-climax... but for the Magpies.

Gradually their voices swelled. Gradually the players responded. There was still majesty in their play, but the morale was undeniable. Macdonald's cross found Burrows with his back to an empty goal - a chance wasted. Macdonald's own shot had Corrigan grasping, but safe. Then Gowling, wriggling clear, spun into a shot which Corrigan turned aside. If this was vain effort, then it was, too, valiant enterprise. Merit, fine and properly, gave the Cup to City. And it was now that the Newcastle fans had their finest moment.

Unusually, Newcastle trooped up first for their medals and, with some unable to restrain tears, they did a slow lap of honour along the front of their forgiving fans. No City's turn, and the warmth and generosity of the 'black and white army' to the sides that had defeated them will long be remembered. It wasn't the mass of the Geordie crowd at Wembley that was so memorable; but their mood.

So ended a competition that, still criticised as 'upstart', had given much to man. From the first rounds to this last act, cash and glory had gone abundantly to those with the courage or resource to seek it.

From the Second Round on 'big' teams like Stoke fell to unconsidered sides like Lincoln, and football was in many senses richer for such oddities. There was a particularly steady erosion of the Second Division challenge, with Blackburn, Blackpool, Luton, and Chelsea all going down to lower-placed sides, and those who failed on the field were often compensated at the turnstile - like Charlton, who had their biggest crowd for years to see QPR overcome them.

Outstanding in the Third Round were the matches at Villa Park, where 41,000 paid to see Manchester United recover and win; at Burnley where a poor team in the League beat the fancied Liverpool; and - especially - at Mansfield, where Coventry were eliminated by a team deep in Division Three. Mansfield maintained their momentum in the Fourth round, knocking over Wolves, and so did Notts County, who had beaten Leeds at Leeds and now took on Everton and won again.

The Fifth Round saw the end of such audacious gestures. Mansfield were hit by four goals from Manchester City, who had also knocked four past Manchester United in the challenge before, and Notts County collapsed at St James through an own goal. The semi-finals will be remembered for the collapse of the steady Middlesbrough side at Maine Road - again by four goals - and the brilliant performance of Spurs' goalkeeper Jennings, who made Newcastle wait for their eventual prize of a Wembley place. Newcastle, having taken three matches to dispose of Norwich, were gaining pace, and the voice of their following was gaining power.

In the final reckoning, though, perhaps the men who had most cause to be grateful to Newcastle supporters were those who struggled to keep Southport alive. Drawn at home to Newcastle in the Second Round, Southport elected to forgo ground advantage to play at St James. They were smashed 6-0 for their temerity, but the gate was 23,000 - and that was almost precisely as many of the total Southport crowd for their first 18 matches in the League. From start to finish of the 1975-76 League Cup then, Newcastle supporters contributed generously - to be hideously ill-rewarded at the end.
