

The United Soccer Association Results 1967



THE United Soccer Association, sanctioned by the United States Soccer Football Association, the Canadian Soccer Football Association, and thereby by FIFA, operated in 1967 with 12 teams. However, due to the short space of time available in which to recruit players, the USA decided to import entire teams to represent its member cities and build its own teams for the 1968 season.

The result was that three English clubs, Wolverhampton Wanderers, Sunderland and Stoke City, crossed the Atlantic and played as the Los Angeles Wolves, Vancouver Royals and Cleveland Stokers respectively. Three Scottish clubs did likewise with Hibernian becoming Toronto City, Aberdeen (Washington Whips) and Dundee United (Dallas Tornado).

Adding a little Irish flavour to the proceedings were the Belfast club, Glentoran, who played as the Detroit Cougars, while Shamrock Rovers from Dublin adopted the name of the Boston Rovers.

The Brazilian club Bangu, of Rio de Janeiro moved to Texas to become the Houston Stars, Italian club Cagliari to Chicago where they were known as the Chicago Mustangs, Dutch club ADO Den Hague to San Francisco as the Golden Gate Gales and from Montevideo, Uruguay, Cerro became the New York Skyliners.

The short season of just 12 games for each team, started shortly after the 1966-7 season in Europe had been completed and ended with enough time for the players to have a break before training for the 1967-8 European season began. Teams were awarded the traditional two points for a win and one for a tie.

Los Angeles, who topped the Western Division, and Washington, who finished first in the East, met in the Final played in Los Angeles. It turned out to be a memorable game with Los Angeles winning 6-5 after extra-time had been played.

The National Professional Soccer League



1967

THE National Professional Soccer League, which was not sanctioned to operate by the United States Soccer Football Association or the Canadian Soccer Football Association, operated in 1967 as an outlaw League, with its clubs barred from playing any clubs who were members of the USSFA, CSA or FIFA.

As a result, the ten NPSL clubs could only play against each other and any player who played for an NPSL club was subject to disciplinary action should he wish to return to play for a club in membership with FIFA.

Unlike the clubs making up the rival United Soccer Association, the NPSL clubs found the time to recruit their own players, also with no restrictions placed on them by the European season each team played 32 games as compared to 12 for the USA.

Some notable players risked suspension to play in the NPSL, including Welsh international inside-forward Phil Woosnam, who played for and coached the Atlanta Chiefs. English international Dennis Viollet, survivor of the Munich plane crash that killed so many of his Manchester United teammates, signed for the Baltimore Bays, where he joined Juan Santisteban, a member of Real Madrid's great European Cup-winning teams of 1958 and 1959. West German international midfielder Horst Szymaniak became a member of the Chicago Spurs and Yugoslav international goalkeeper Blagoje Vidinic moved to the Pacific coast to play for the Los Angeles Toros where one of his teammates was Mexican international Salvador Reyes.

New York signed Argentinian striker Cesar Menotti, who coached Argentina's World Cup-winning team in 1970, while the Pittsburgh Phantoms included Dutch international Co Prins on their roster. In Toronto the famous Ladislav Kubala came out of retirement to play alongside his son Branko while in St Louis, Yugoslav internationals Bora Kostic and Dragoslav Sekularac played for the Stars.

The NPSL also introduced a new and highly controversial points system, with six points being awarded for a win, three for a tie and one point for every goal scored up to three per team. This meant that a team winning 3-2 picked up six points for the victory and three more for scoring three goals for a total of nine. The losing team picked up two points for the two goals it scored. The object was to reward attacking soccer so crucial to the success of the League.

In addition to this the NPSL kept track of players assisting a goalscorer as well as the goalscorer himself and awarded one point for an assist and two for a goal in the individual scoring statistics. Hence a player scoring a goal and setting up two others was credited with four points.

April 16 was opening day for the NPSL and the regular season came to a close at the end of August. This was followed by a two-game play-off for the championship between the winners of the Eastern Division, the Baltimore Bays, and the winners of the Western Division, the Oakland Clippers. Baltimore won the first game 1-0 in Baltimore, while Oakland took the second 4-1, thus winning the NPSL championship on a 4-2 aggregate.
