

## Review of the Season

Celtic are champions for the eighth time in Scotland, a situation approaching monopoly. Their remarkable record, under the brilliant managership of Jock Stein, can be fully appreciated only if one considers its unique consistency. Stein had to re-build the team without loss of efficiency, and never looked for an excuse for merely 'consolidating'. The present side might not yet be quite so exciting as the European Cup winning team of 1967, but its potential is limitless. In George Connelly they have Scotland's 'Footballer of the Year', Danny McGrain is an excellent young full-back, and both Kenny Dalglish and Dixie Deans are players with a great future in the game. Their defeat against the Hungarians, Ujpest Dozsa was a disappointment, but Celtic will always represent Scotland in Europe with honour, and next season could easily become the first British club to win the trophy twice.

Celtic's success in the 1972-73 Championship was predictable. What was not was the superb recovery by Rangers in the League in which they finished runners-up after one of the worst starts in their history. The anti-climax of disappointment for the largest following in Scotland was offset by winning the Scottish Cup - against Celtic.

The Ibrox club, banned for a year from Europe after the infamous crowd scenes in Barcelona when they beat Dynamo Moscow in the Cup-Winners' Cup Final, return to the same tournament, and, because of their tremendous crowd-drawing power, officials of UEFA and leading European clubs have welcomed them. Moreover, Rangers have an outstanding chance to repeat their 1971 victory.

It was a mixed season for Hibernians, the Edinburgh club. Guided by manager Eddie Turnbull they won two major early-season competitions, the Dryborough and League Cups, but faced with games in Europe and a tough domestic tussle with Celtic and Rangers in the championship they shaded off. How much of this was due to a cruel leg-break sustained by right back John Brownlie, one of the brightest of Scottish players, at a critical part of the season and an SFA suspension imposed on forward Alex Edwards we shall never know. Anyway, Hibs promise to be one of the good teams next season and will certainly not be far from the top - if, indeed, they don't finish there. They play attractively and have succeeded in bringing back thousands of fans to Easter Road, which is an achievement in itself.

What Scottish football needs more than anything is a more competitive league and it is clubs like Hibs who will provide this.

The promoted teams, Second Division champions Clyde and Dunfermline, will have harder jobs than ever to stay up. It has been much more difficult in the close season to fix up experienced players who could help youngsters over the first months of First Division football.

Internationally, Scotland lost Tommy Docherty to Manchester United. This was a severe blow, for The Doc had built up the team and excited the fans about World Cup prospects after beating Denmark twice. Docherty also took with him to Old Trafford the first £200,000 home Scot, Lou Macari, from Celtic.

The new Scots boss, Willie Ormond, former St. Johnstone manager, retains Macari in his pool, and he has spelt out clearly what he wants in the efforts to beat Czechoslovakia to qualify for the World Cup finals in W. Germany.

Next season could be the most exciting for years in Europe at club level and with a Scotland team confirmed by then as World Cup contenders.
