

Review of the Season

The phenomenal Celtic have yet again dominated Scottish football with a world record-equalling ninth championship win in a row. Their success, made absolute by beating Dundee United 3-0 in the Scottish Cup final at Hampden Park, has edged legislators at long last to change to a three league set-up next season of 10-14-14 in a bold move to extract the imbalance from the Championship. Celtic, however, have rightly and properly pointed out that while they support change and progress, the one way to beat them is to be more efficient on the field.

Under Jock Stein, Celtic have thrown off every sign of a challenge and, frankly, they could easily win the title for a tenth time before reorganisation takes place. Next year there will be 38 teams and three leagues. Ferranti Thistle, an Edinburgh works side, were called in despite hot opposition, particularly from Highland League club Inverness Thistle, to make up the numbers and ensure that Second Division sides don't have an uneven number and, therefore, a game-less Saturday.

There will be 12 teams in the Super League which ensures, of course, that the prizes this season will be greater than at any other time in the history of Scottish football. The 12 best teams in the present First Division will form the new Super League. The remaining six join the top eight in the minor division to form the new First Division. The remainder will play in the Second Division and there will be promotion and relegation from each League.

Will this be an instant cure for Scottish football? Almost certainly not, but it is a move towards sensible change with clubs forced to find their own level with new and increased guarantees - £1000 among the top 12 - and pay more attention to football than side-attractions such as development funds and the lucrative pools cash which was £345 a point last season. Quite astonishingly, Ferranti Thistle will earn a share of this merely by paying the League a trivial membership fee. However, despite League changes Celtic have set such a fantastic pace that the others will have a lot of catching up to do.

Since the voting was 29 clubs for and only eight against the change, it's clear how apparent it was that a major switch-over was needed after so many abortive attempts that even League Secretary Tommy Maule lost count. Hibs showed, by paying £120,000 to Everton for striker Joe Harper, that they mean business. Celtic, on the other hand - always prudent buyers - argue there is no market for such expensive purchases in Scotland. They prefer to find star men like Billy McNeill as boys and assure them a cash-earning benefit towards the end of their careers. Celtic chairman Desmond White argues logically, that this is the only way to keep stars in Scotland, so great are attractions in the South.

Hibs will join Celtic on the European trail, having beaten Rangers for second place in the league and thus qualified for the UEFA Cup. Dundee United, as losing finalists, go into the Cup-Winners' Cup. It is worrying for Rangers that they have to be happy with one of the four Texaco Cup places - the others go to Aberdeen, Hearts, and Ayr - but manager Jock Wallace promises big things this season. He has already produced two of the most promising youngsters of the season in striker Alex O'Hara and wing-half Ian McDougall. Rangers have a potential following of at least 50,000. This has fallen only because their most ardent fans cannot bear to compare their team's record with that of rivals Celtic. So the pressure on Rangers to do well this season is going to be tremendous.

Hibs started well by winning the Drybrough Cup but they fell away at a crucial point much to the disappointment of manager Eddie Turnbull. They will be a team to watch this season, though. Dundee played with much style when they beat Celtic in the League Cup final and in striker John Duncan they certainly have Scotland's best player *not*

championship this season. It would, in fact, be a considerable and much-needed boost for football in the Jute City, as attendances have slumped and even on their Cup run to the final at Hampden, manager Jim McLean, of United, was forced to complain bitterly about lack of support.

The new League set-up will throw out a challenge to supporters as well as clubs. If they don't turn out to see the revamped games, then even more desperate measures will have to be taken. Clubs could disappear and others be forced to amalgamate.

The match most Scots will want to forget was Celtic against Atlético Madrid. Spurred by their Argentinian manager Juan Carlos Lorenzo, Atlético booted their way viciously into the final, and it was pretty meagre consolation that Bayern Munich beat the Spanish club 4-0 in the final replay in Brussels.

European and world football is still, of course, the prime target for Scotland and its clubs. But the fact that matches against England are still such a sell-out attraction surely means that the British International Championship will go on. That 2-0 win against Joe Mercer's English side at Hampden was the best possible World Cup boost our team could have been given.

And there is the other point that so long as Scotland can produce 18-year-olds like striker Andy Gray of Dundee United, already much sought and valued at £150,000, we have not a lot to fear.

The future, however, lies in a big-time approach and that is why a club such as Ayr United would have to think seriously about full-time football should they finish in the top 12 at the end of the season, as they are very likely to do. Their performances this season have been outstanding under manager Ally MacLeod, but they and the two promoted teams, Airdrie and Kilmarnock, should face the fact that life at the top is for big thinkers. The clubs who want to live on a shoestring will have to find their place lower down the ladder.

Anyway, Scotland is going to be a football pressure chamber for the next year, which should be great fun for the fans.
