

Review of the Season

Scottish football has emerged unscathed from the trauma of battling for places in a new three-league set-up. The next problem is making the system succeed. Sceptics think this will be difficult, for the ten Premier League teams have to meet four times in the League, and the two other divisions of 14 have to make themselves competitively attractive to the customers. It took umpteen years of abortive efforts to achieve the fresh set-up which, unfairly, Celtic fans feel was specifically designed to curb their team's phenomenal success.

In fact, they lost the League *after* the scheme was approved by the 37 clubs (Meadowbank were later admitted to make it an even 38) so no such charge is valid.

Rangers won the championship, breaking the startling success of Jock Stein-inspired Celtic after nine splendid world record-equalling years. Seen in total neutrality, it was a good victory for football and was achieved by Rangers on merit, for they beat Celtic in both League matches.

Rangers' drawing power is extraordinary. So is Celtic's, but their fans were becoming blasé about success, and their selectivity cut gates at minor matches. This season it will be a totally new ball-game. All 38 clubs will be going hell-for-leather to prove themselves — and make their teams pay at the gates with the lack of interest of commercial firms like Texaco.

Rangers did a super job finishing top. They were driven there by the hard-talking Jock Wallace, one-time jungle fighter, who has little time for the tactical mumbo-jumbo of text-book coaches. Wallace believes that effort, honesty, and loyalty are the basis on which a player's skill has to be founded. In Sandy Jardine he found a ready example. Jardine, at the end of a hard season, was voted by the Scottish Football Writers' Association as the Player of the Year.

Celtic, however, could not be kept out of the reckoning. Having won the League and Dryborough Cups at the start of the season they sagged dramatically after losing to Rangers on January 2.

However, a footballer is as good as his last kick and Celtic finished by beating part-time Airdrie in the Scottish Cup Final. It was a shame for Airdrie, as they failed to make the Top Ten. And yet they were the most successful spare-time team — even though Ally MacLeod's Ayr United made the Premier League. However, there was no doubt Celtic deserved to win the Cup.

Nor, indeed, could it be disputed that after 18 years at the top Billy McNeill deserved to retire with the Cup in one hand and a medal in the other. McNeill has been a credit to Scottish football. Kenny Dalglish, who showed his club form for the first time in the Scottish team in the Home internationals, could very well take over the McNeill role. McNeill has certainly been his mentor. It looks as though he has done a good job in guiding him both on and off the field.

Hibs ended the season with a bright challenge. They were, nevertheless, a disappointment by their own standards. They will hope to make a big impression in Europe in the new season.

It is important for the success of the new set-up that the lesser teams also do well. There will be little point in the league change if Rangers and Celtic merely continue to prosper and the others, from Hibs down, have to struggle to make ends meet. It will be vital for teams like Partick Thistle, Kilmarnock and Airdrie, to make a go of the First Division, and for clubs like Stenhousemuir and Forfar to find customer-interest in the Second Division.

Scottish football is at a crossroads this season. They must revitalise interest, and a good run in Europe will help to achieve this. More clubs have turned to part-time football but this is out of realism rather than downright pessimism.

Scottish players must realise they have to fight to gain the support of the fans or the game on this side of the border will drastically curtail itself without actually going out of business. The road to 1976 has to be smoothed.
