Review of Scottish Season

This season's league programme was vividly exciting to the end: Rangers, occupying an unusual bottom-of-the-table position at the beginning of the season, soon remedied that, and by mid-October were firmly ahead of the field and at one time looked to be coasting home; Aberdeen started to nudge up, however, gaining a point here and a point there and in the end it all depended on their last games. Rangers won theirs in convincing style, and with it the championship. Many would have liked to see an Aberdeen success, but no-one could deny that Rangers were worthy champions: new blood made them an exciting team, and their football was always sound and at times brilliant. Aberdeen achieved much in their first season under Billy McNeill. They played imaginative and at times devastating football; and their support grew in proportion to their standing. Dundee United, with a young team, promised much but seemed to lose the way to goal; third position, none the less, was a notable achievement. Hibs found their form in mid-season, and showed increasing class and penetration. Celtic had a bitterly disappointing season: there were several factors to explain their appalling form after last year's successes: the departure of Kenny Dalglish for the fleshpots of the south they might have borne with fortitude – if not equanimity – but the injury to Danny McGrain – what a cruel blow to Scotland, too – and the absence of other stalwarts and experienced players meant that Celtic never looked settled. Unusually, Jock Stein went into the buying market and some of his purchases caused an eyebrow or two to rise; the blend did not come, and a final fifth position meant that Celtic were not in a European competition for the first time in many years. At the lower end, Clydebank started badly and were soon out of touch with the rest; they are joined in the drop by Ayr United, who this time failed to find the New Year surge to safety.

In the first division there was a three-horse race: Morton, Hearts and Dundee all at times looked capable of holding their own in top company. There was suspense till the last afternoon when, although Dundee defeated Morton at Greenock, Hearts achieved the win they needed to join the already safe Morton. Well done Benny Rooney! And well done Willie Ormond in managing to bounce-back in one season! But spare a thought for Tommy Gemmill and his team who played attacking and attractive football, but had to suffer the bitterness of being the odd one out. East Fife, lucky to avoid relegation last season, had no difficulty in reaching it this time. Down with them go Alloa, who never quite looked the part in this division.

Up to Division One go Clyde: they have served their time downstairs, and now have much more of the lean and hungry look: if they can find the same inspiration, they can do well next season. With them go Raith Rovers, now managed by Willie McLean, and gaining poise from the return of Gordon Wallace (the elder) from Dundee United. (Incidentally, it would make the writer's task much easier if teams were banned from having two players with the same name!) Dunfermline again missed the boat, showing great inconsistency; and challenges from Berwick, Falkirk and Forfar all evaporated: the right teams are going up.

The new form of the League Cup proved most successful, though the weather mid-term caused a postponement of the semi-finals and final into the Spring. In a lack-lustre final, Rangers won by the odd goal in three. No mention of this year's tournament, however, can fail to note the wonderful deeds of Forfar Athletic – some powerful scalps to their credit, and within seven minutes of a place in the final before finally succumbing to the might of Rangers.

The Cup produced rather few excitements this year. Kilmarnock reached the quarter-finals, having disposed of St Mirren and Celtic on the way; and Queen's Park brought back thoughts of old days by also reaching that stage of the competition, by way of Motherwell in the previous round. So to the final, contested by the two best teams in the country: it was a game in which the score (2-1 to Rangers) failed to do the champions justice. Through the season, Aberdeen had the better of the encounters; but this one was Rangers' day, and John Greig's as well – what a fine way to end a testimonial season for this magnificent servant to the club.

So, finally, to the Home Internationals – all three at Hampden. If the results were not to the liking of the partisan crowds, they none the less gave the best possible support to Ally MacLeod and his side after the last match and before their departure for Argentina. It was heartening to find the whole country so solidly behind its players.
