## THE SCOTTISH SEASON 1981-82

When the time comes to review one season, it is almost time to begin the next. There are plenty who look forward to the start of a new season and we live in high hopes that it will be as interesting as the last; we remember many good matches, notable goals, unusual decisions -- and quietly forget those freezing evenings when nothing happened for 90 minutes and we wondered why we had bothered to come out at all.

The League Cup programme opened in 1981-82 at the beginning of August, and interest was immediately aroused when Celtic were defeated on the first day by St Mirren, and subsequently by St Johnstone. From such a start they could not recover, and for the first time in many years they failed to reach the final stages. Notable achievements came from Brechin and Forfar, both of whom won their sections against First Division opposition. The quarter-finals were completed without any upsets, and after the semi-finals, in which Rangers just managed to overcome St Mirren, and Dundee United won a splendid victory over Aberdeen after trailing in the first leg, the final was fought out at Hampden. United missed their chances in a first half which they dominated, and Rangers took over as the game progressed, just managing to edge ahead in the final minutes.

Celtic, smarting from their League Cup rebuff, were at the top of the Premier Division throughout the whole season, winning their first seven games and establishing a seemingly unbreachable lead. In the New Year Aberdeen lost to Celtic on 30 January in a game which came, with perhaps more luck than insight, heralded as the championship decider. In February, though, Aberdeen had three no-score draws and a win over Airdrie and in their next sixteen games Aberdeen scored 46 goals whilst only conceding 10. Apart from a setback when they lost 1-3 to Morton in mid-April, they brushed aside all opposition, and Celtic supporters, sitting comfortably wondering who was going to come second, suddenly found an uncomfortable gale about their necks, relieved only when their team scored the goals which gave them victory and the championship, late in their last match. Rangers were still unconvincing, and in a stage of transition. Dundee United, an exciting team to watch, were going well until the break enforced by the weather; thereafter they showed some uncertainty, but finished with two important wins to regain their place in Europe. Aberdeen established themselves nicely in the middle of the table, and proved that they could be difficult to beat, while Morton, with a rather indifferent away record, kept out of trouble but never showed much of a challenge for the lead. The three teams at the bottom spent some time in sorting their final order; although Airdrie looked lost by mid-April, the Thistle challenge went on for longer, and Dundee just managed to hold them off, the final cushion of four points not really indicating the closeness of the final encounters. Dundee were something of an enigma, reported to be playing much better than their league position warranted. None the less, it is the points that count, and it is an indication of the competition aroused by such a small number in the Premier Division that a team like Dundee has no time to re-establish itself on promotion, but must hoard points like gold from the start of the season.

Motherwell, a well-balanced side astutely managed by David Hay, ran away with the First Division; there was a stern battle for the second promotion spot, and Hearts, who had looked favourites for it, came unstuck at the last fence as Kilmarnock, with a vast final victory, went ahead of them. Clydebank and St Johnstone had been up with the others until the last month, but fell away, whilst Ayr, who had looked promotion contenders until February, slipped slowly down the list. East Stirling and Queen of the South were obvious relegation candidates for some time; Dumbarton, after a weak start, drew into safety and Raith Rovers, unable to recapture previous form, were happy to avoid the drop. The other teams, including a Queen's Park side which had a very sound season, were not in serious contention in either direction.

It was almost the same story at the top of the Second Division, for Clyde were quickly ahead of the field, and ran out convincing winners. Again, the contest for the second place was sharp, and five teams were in the hunt until the last moment. Alloa eventually edged ahead of Arbroath on goal difference, but there was tremendous cut-and-thrust between the leaders in the last weeks, and anything could have happened.

The Cup team of the year was Forfar Athletic. They reached the quarter-finals of the League Cup, but went one better in the Scottish Cup, disposing of First Division opponents Hamilton, Hearts and Queen's Park on the way. Then, in the semi-final with Rangers at Hampden, they threatened to cause a cataclysmic upset until Rangers convincingly won the resulting replay. Aberdeen, scoring after only a few seconds in their third-round match against Motherwell, nevertheless found the First Division leaders a handful and that proved

to be the only goal of a fascinating and exciting game. If Aberdeen deserved their win, Motherwell at least came away from the encounter with their reputation enhanced. Aberdeen's next-round encounter removed Celtic from the competition, again by just one goal. Eventually Aberdeen were worthy winners in the final, though after extra time and following an early Rangers goal which must have been one of their best in the season.

The Highland League was won by Inverness Caledonian, who displaced Keith from the perch after an imposing run at the top.

In the two top European tournaments, Scottish representatives did not get far, but the UEFA Cup was a different story. The exploits of Dundee United were soon acclaimed furth of Scotland, for they took five away goals against Monaco, another five in a scintillating display against the much-fancied Borussia Moenchengladbach, and yet another five in the next round against Winterslag. Then came that break for the weather, and United failed in the away leg of their Yugoslavian match - a sore disappointment after the magnificent earlier displays. Aberdeen, with a team containing even more Scots than their opponents, had a triumphant encounter with Ipswich Town, then currently at the head of the English league; they swept through the next round, but faltered in the home leg against SV Hamburg, and had an insufficient lead for the away game. Our teams did us well this year and, with experience in Europe counting for much, it is good to see the same teams again taking the European field in the coming season.

So much has been said and written about our luck in the World Cup draw that it is barely worth further comment. Scotland went out to Spain as underdogs, with the minimum of ballyhoo and the maximum of sensibly expressed comment from the manager. It was so close! Yet, at the end of the day, for all our disappointment, we may well be pleased with our team and with their overall showing. It is also appropriate to congratulate the enormous number of fans who found their way to Spain and gave their team such excellent support. It remains only to congratulate England and Northern Ireland on reaching the secondary stage. Meanwhile, we are already looking forward four years, to next time.
