

## THE SCOTTISH SEASON 1985-86



Overshadowing all else that happened this season was the loss to Scottish football of Jock Stein. He was a great but modest man, whose influence on the game was immeasurable on the national side, on the clubs he managed, and on a myriad of players, young and old. He is sadly missed but in no way forgotten.

Ructions seemed imminent in the League set up, and for a long while it appeared that insanity might prevail. To those involved in the prolonged negotiations, it must have seemed a downhill move toward destruction, but in the end a compromise was reached and all now looks set hopefully for an arrangement which will at least give the full-time clubs the chance to consolidate.

Out on the field which, you might think, is where it matters, there was what proved to be one of the best league programmes. When the national team was involved in a visit to Australia, fixtures were upended in the Premier Division, but Hearts, after an indifferent start to the season, managed to keep their fixtures going, and they stole almost inadvertently to the top of the table. No one took this very seriously at the time, but Hearts refused to give up their position and, brushing aside all opposition, they went for 27 league games without defeat, and entered the final straight needing only a modest draw to clinch their first major title since 1960. Alas! it was not to be: Celtic, finishing strongly with eight wins, scored a basketful on the last day to oust Hearts from their position by a slender margin on goal difference. All were disappointed for Hearts, who had come so near, but Celtic, who had not looked really menacing till the run in, are to be congratulated on their fifth Premier title. Dundee United and Aberdeen, hot contenders at the turn of the year, both faltered and rather uncharacteristically failed to maintain their challenge when it mattered, though both teams were plagued by injuries at vital times. Rangers promised much early, but they fell away and had an undistinguished season, particularly away from home; boardroom rearrangements, and the departure of Jock Wallace, allowed for the appointment of Graeme Souness as player/manager and all football fans – and especially Rangers supporters – look forward to next season with eager anticipation. Dundee had a good season overall, and very nearly took the fifth European place from Rangers. Clydebank and

Motherwell vied for bottom place, but they both became less frantic once they knew that relegation did not threaten them this season.

In the First Division Hamilton Accies were always well to the fore, and they are now set to leave this division for the first time. Although, once their top spot was clinched, they relaxed and had some less good results, they did quite enough earlier to indicate that they should be able to tackle sterner opposition with some confidence next season. The fight for the second promotion spot was hard: Dumbarton, then Kilmarnock, then Falkirk all challenged; with two games to go, Forfar suddenly went ahead of the rest, but they could not hold their place, and Falkirk just edged in, with the rest a short head behind. East Fife, though never quite looking like promotion probables, had their best season in years and finished fifth. The other eight teams were all intimately concerned in the relegation shuffle: Alloa were the first to lose touch, but the rest scrambled to avoid that other place: in the end it was Ayr United who joined Alloa in the move to the Second Division, but it was a close thing right to the end.

Coming up to the First Division are Dunfermline Athletic and Queen of the South. They drew steadily ahead from the first days of the season, and although Queen's Park and Meadowbank Thistle each had determined runs, and Stirling Albion finished strongly, none could alter the top positions. Dunfermline, with vastly larger crowds than other clubs in the Second or First Divisions, will indeed be welcome in the upper division. They are an ambitious club, and could well be challenging for further honours soon.

The Skol Cup again proved a popular early season event. There were few upsets, but notable were Hamilton's defeat of Dundee, and Hibs' vast early scoring when they were being totally unsuccessful in their league games; Hibs also disposed of Celtic after a high scoring game and penalties, and subsequently removed the other half of the Old Firm to reach the final with Aberdeen. In a good though rather one-sided game, Aberdeen gave Alex Ferguson the one home trophy he still wanted, and, incidentally, Aberdeen won the cup without conceding a single goal.

The Cup also ran more or less to form. Highland League clubs made their mark, with Nairn county defeating Meadowbank before going down to Dundee, and newcomers Fort William earning a replay with Stirling Albion after a brave draw. Hibs once again defeated Celtic, while Hearts accounted for Rangers in their first game. An all-Edinburgh final was possible at the semi-final stage, but Aberdeen were too good for Hibs, while Hearts won by the odd goal against Dundee United in a game which did not really fulfil expectations. Hearts, fresh from their disappointment at losing the league, were never quite in the hunt against a rampant Aberdeen in the final. Although Hearts finished with no trophies, their reputation was much enhanced, and there could be considerable consolation in their assistant-manager Sandy Jardine being voted Player of the Year.

In the Highland League, there was no room at the top for the usual teams. Elgin City finished their programme with a healthy lead, but they could still be caught by two teams, each with three games left to play. Peterhead fumbled the chance, but Forres Mechanics came through triumphantly to record their first title.

The European games this year were rather disappointing in the end. Celtic and Rangers both disappeared quickly; St Mirren gave a rousing performance, and then lost after seeming to be in an impregnable position; while Dundee United and Aberdeen went past the early stages with some ease. United were eventually unlucky to lose to Neuchatel Xamax, though they should have made sure in the first leg: a great second half performance at Tannadice on deepening snow, when they ran rings round the Swiss team, led to their just failing to score enough goals. Aberdeen worked their way into the semi-finals, but failed to take advantage of what looked like the easiest draw (though there are no easy teams at this stage). Two goals conceded at Pittodrie in a drawn game proved an insuperable obstacle, and the second leg was goalless. Let no credit be taken from the Swedes who played with skill and enthusiasm, and took their opportunities when away from home.

We made it all very difficult to qualify for our fourth consecutive World Cup: the draw against Wales, overshadowed by the death of Jock Stein; the non-too-convincing win against a hard-working but not very talented Australian team at Hampden, and the perhaps rather more convincing shut-out in Melbourne. Well, we are in Mexico, but in a brute of a section. Everyone is very hopeful, but there can be no overconfidence in the camp. It is a shame that, in the season in which he won his 100th cap, was given the freedom of his native Glasgow, and won the English League and Cup double as player/manager, Kenny Dalglish should miss his fourth World Cup through injury; and how much we could still do with his experience and flair. However, we have a useful squad available, and can now wish Alex Ferguson and his team good luck, and hope they will produce the form of which they are capable.
