

The Scottish Season 1986-87

Salute first the team which won nothing. Dundee United magnificently defeated some of Europe's best before going down gallantly in the second leg of the UEFA cup final three days after losing at Hampden in the Scottish Cup final. Salute, too, their inspirational manager, Jim McLean, and also the fans who did so much to convince those abroad that Scotland's clubs and their support may be welcomed wherever they go. Perhaps, after all, they did win something more than the tangible trophies.

With 44 games in both the Premier and First Divisions, the League programme looked as if it would be a long, hard struggle, and such it proved to be. That it did not run into disaster and the middle of the summer was due (to some small extent) to heated pitches, to a larger extent to comparatively short spells of interference from the weather, and to good management.

There was much interest in the team which Graeme Souness had assembled, at vast cost, at Ibrox, and it made the worst possible start with a bad-tempered flare-up in which the new manager was dismissed from the park. It took a while after this for the team to settle. Again and again it has been shown that it is no use just buying expensive players and hoping the team will do well; Souness gave a firm indication of what he wanted from his players, and his astute purchase of the services of Terry Butcher, who was appointed team captain, soon paid off. Rangers, with a strong and sound defence, improved all the time. The crowds flocked back, and Rangers, making up nine points on Celtic in the process, swept into the lead and from then on the championship looked theirs. It was their first in ten years, and there was unconcealed and understandable delight from all at Ibrox and their fans.

Celtic did not enjoy the season all that much. They failed in the cup competitions, and lost what appeared to be an unassailable lead in the League. Their defence often seemed suspect at top level, but their scoring duo of Brian McClair and Mo Johnston always kept them in the hunt. At the end of the day the table had an old-fashioned appearance with the Old Firm in the top two places.

Dundee United, Aberdeen and Hearts kept up with the top group until well into the New Year, but their challenge diminished as the weeks went by. Then came a middle group, soon cut off from the leaders, but in no trouble; of these, Dundee, who had a better season, finished well adrift of the top group, but well ahead of St Mirren. Finally came the relegation battle amongst five clubs: Motherwell and Hibernian were always at the comfortable end of this, and drew into safety, leaving Falkirk and Clydebank to contest the second relegation place. Hamilton Accies, after an appalling start, never escaped from the shackles of bottom place save for one brief moment.

Division I was, as usual, a difficult place to be. Dunfermline soon made their presence felt, and looked good to win the 2nd and 1st Divisions in consecutive seasons; they faltered in the closing stages, and a series of indifferent results allowed Morton to sweep past and take the flag, leaving them, however, safely in second spot and now aiming to establish themselves for the first time in the Premier Division next season. The challenges from the nearest clubs, in particular Dumbarton, fizzled out, and in the last weeks there was the almost ludicrous spectacle of the top clubs losing all too frequently to those at the foot of the table. Montrose were too far behind, though, and succumbed first, but Brechin had a spirited run, only just failing to overhaul Queen of the South, and thus joining Montrose in the return to Division II.

Division II was, in the later stages at least, the most competitive. Meadowbank, never far from the lead, eventually won several times when it really mattered, and topped the final table. Ayr had an excellent run, and passed Raith Rovers who, seemingly impregnable earlier, had had a series of unwanted draws and looked to have blown it. Coming up fast from behind, Stirling Albion were all ready to step in should anyone falter. The last day was fascinating: Stirling, playing Ayr, were two up at half-time, and at that stage were in the promotion position, for Raith were only drawing at Stranraer; Raith started the second half with quick goals, gaining the win which put them into second place by a narrow margin over Stirling, with Ayr, who had needed only a point, a whisker behind. St Johnstone had fallen away after a good run; Alloa did well early on; and Cowdenbeath had their moments. For the rest, there were some good performances, but no real challenge for the top.

The Highland League was won by Inverness Thistle, who had to dispose of a strong challenge from Caley. Thistle were all but at the post with the record of a complete season without defeat, but three minutes from the end of the season they lost a goal, and with it their chance of the record. No matter: they had taken the champion's flag with distinction and, in the end, with a fair margin.

The Skol Cup gets the season away to a good start. Although most are agreed that it is unsatisfactory to settle a game by penalties, no better way has yet been devised to conclude a game in one session – and it does make for excitement. Nearly a quarter of the ties had to go to extra time, and four of these led to penalty shootouts: of these, one concerned the eventual winners, Rangers (just one penalty miss by East Fife) and two Celtic (against Aberdeen and Motherwell). Shock of the early rounds was Montrose's defeat of Hearts at Tynecastle, but Clyde, Ayr and Forfar all beat teams in senior divisions. There were many close games, and in the end it came to an Old Firm final, settled in the end in favour of Rangers by a penalty.

The Scottish Cup had its usual share of special performances: both Caley and Peterhead defeated League opposition to advance; Caley found the visit to Love St too much for them, but will doubtless tell all in the north that the side which defeated them now has the Cup on its sideboard. Peterhead advanced into the Third Round by defeating East Stirlingshire and Rothes; they then saw off Clyde, and were faced with the possibility of a first time ever quarter-final. Could they do it? The answer was 'No', but it took Raith Rovers three games to overcome them. The undoubtedly shock of the competition was Rangers' rapid exit to Hamilton at their first showing – and at Ibrox at that. Funny enough, this could have been a help to Rangers in the League: apart from not having to concentrate on two fronts, it gave them a firm determination not to earn more gibes and snide laughs. Aberdeen and Celtic were unlucky to meet in their first match, and this encounter needed three games to settle the issue. The first, on TV on a very frosty Sunday, could have gone Celtic's way when they were two goals ahead, though justice was done on a pitch not fully playable. In the second replay, Celtic triumphed, but their success was short-lived for they lost in the next round to Hearts, who had their own difficulties – and three games – in defeating Kilmarnock.

St Mirren had progressed quietly, and avoiding the big guns. They had an excellent and close victory against Morton at Cappielow, and did well again to eliminate Hearts in the semi-finals. They were joined in the final by Dundee United, who had their own hurdles, with drawn games against Airdrie and Forfar. In the final, watched by a well-behaved crowd in holiday mood, the play was a disappointment and the game did not reach great heights. In the end, an Ian Ferguson goal in the second period of extra time was sufficient to bring the cup to St Mirren for the first time since 1959. Alex Smith is to be congratulated on his first success with the club.

In the European club competitions, Dundee United gave shining performances, but the others did not progress far, though they gave good accounts of themselves. On the international front we had rather little to offer. Andy Roxburgh's plans never quite produced what he wanted, and we went out of Europe without difficulty. On the whole the teams look good in defence, but we lack the dominant players in midfield, and the strikers have all too few chances. You do not win many games without goals. We keep hoping, and are now looking forward to the next World Cup. Can we really hope to qualify yet again? I think we can, but it does depend on finding and sticking to players who are prepared to give a full commitment to each game, however late it may come in the season. Dilettante performances are no good, and we have seen them from some. Crowds of youngsters and their parents at the Cup Final, packed houses at Ibrox and elsewhere, show that there is plenty of interest from the fans, and the national side will surely keep its generous backing if it can face its task with a real desire to go ahead.
