

THE SCOTTISH SEASON 1988-89

The Skol Cup was a good curtain-raiser for the season. There is no doubt that the public wants instant results in all sport nowadays, and the knowledge that there is bound to be a result attracts the supporters. In general there were few upsets, and bigger teams took their due place above the smaller; but plenty of matches went to extra time, and several to penalty shoot-outs: Falkirk finally disposed of Raith Rovers 9-8 after the penalties. In the later stages, Dundee U defeated Celtic to reach the semi-finals, where they lost to Aberdeen; the other beaten semi-finalists were Hearts, and another Rangers-Aberdeen final proved an exciting contest, the Dons twice drawing level before Ally McCoist settled the issue a couple of minutes from the end.

In the Premier Division it was not long before Hamilton Academical lost the place, and by Christmas they were well adrift at the foot of the table. This meant that the next group up were clear of the threat of relegation. The top four – Rangers, Aberdeen, Celtic, Dundee U – were soon, realistically, the only teams likely to produce the champions. Dundee U had a poor home record, Aberdeen had too many draws, Celtic made a hash of the early season; that left Rangers in the driving seat, and although everyone talked about “taking nothing for granted” and “we still have a chance”, to the unbiased there was only one team in it short of a series of major upsets. None occurred, and Rangers duly took the title. They did have their injuries, but their expensive squad was more or less limitless, and they coped. At their best, they were a joy to watch; at their worst – occasionally – they still usually managed to do enough to gain points. It was not until late on that Hibernian clinched the 5th European place. Hearts, who had a wonderful run in Europe, did not find form in the League, and though for a moment they looked capable of mounting a challenge to Hibs, it fizzled out. St Mirren had their moments, but they were far too inconsistent.

There was interest in the First and Second Divisions right to the end of the season – in fact, in the First Division the issue was not finally settled until the last minutes being added on when a penalty was awarded: on that penalty depended the fates of Clyde and Kilmarnock: Colin McGlashan bravely converted the penalty against St Johnstone for Clyde (incidentally, the fourth he had scored in the last five matches) and down went Kilmarnock; they had scored six at Palmerston Park, but Clyde had the better goal difference – by one.

At the top of the division there was only one place to play for. Dunfermline made the early running, but other teams were ready to make their move. When Dunfermline faltered, Falkirk, Airdrie and Morton were there; St Johnstone and Clydebank, too, were not far off. The interest was kept up and on the last Saturday Falkirk could still have displaced Dunfermline, the leaders: they failed, and were thus left in the First Division for at least another year. There is continued stirring to try to increase the size of the Premier Division, and in truth one place is not much to aim at. The larger Premier Division was not really a success for the top clubs. Forty-four league games was too many when you add to that the Cup and Skol Cup games, perhaps a few in Europe, and other commitments. Two up, two down with a ten-club Premier Division really means a lack of security for the lower clubs in the Premier Division where a drop to the First Division means a very serious loss of income. What is the answer? A play-off has been suggested, with no. 2 in the First Division challenging no. 9 in the Premier Division; but this would mean everything depending upon two games at the end of a long season, where almost anything can happen. Is this really satisfactory? There is no simple answer – different sections of the division have different priorities, different requirements: there is no place for a compromise.

The Second Division was very competitive: Albion Rovers took a useful lead at the halfway stage, and maintained it – partly because of the cut-throat play amongst the teams below. The Wee Rovers confirmed their position as champions, for the first time since 1934. There was a scramble to join them in promotion. A month before the end, there were still six teams in with a good chance; and when the last game was played, three clubs had equal points, with one only a point adrift of them. Of the three, Alloa won their game and maintained their second position to gain promotion; Brechin defeated rivals East Fife, but had an inferior goal difference to Alloa; Stirling Albion, once again, were there or therabouts. Perhaps the most remarkable achievement in the Second Division came from Berwick Rangers: with only three points, they were firmly anchored at the bottom of the division at the beginning of December; they then had a run of twenty-one games without defeat, easily their best ever – and moved just one place up the table! Indeed, after thirteen of these twenty-one games they were still bottom – surely a record for all time.

In the Scottish Cup there were few flutters; no non-League clubs reached the third round, and about the only minor upset was the defeat of St Mirren by Partick after a replay; the

Buddies have not had a happy time in cup games since they won the Cup two seasons ago. Stranraer continued their visits to the top spots: last year they had only just lost at Celtic Park; this year they were trounced at Ibrox, but even so, they gave a good account of themselves. St Johnstone, after several encounters with First and Second Division opposition reached the semi-finals, where they lost to Rangers only after a replay. Hibs were the other losing semi-finalists. Rangers and Celtic, managing to keep clear of each other in the usual skilful way, eventually met in the final. Rangers were chasing the treble; Celtic were desperate to avoid a bare trophy cabinet. There was much to play for. There were, said the pundits, all the ingredients for a classic encounter. Well, of course, that is the recipe for just the opposite, and in truth, it was not a great game; but it remained good-tempered both amongst the players and the crowd. Celtic were delighted with Joe Miller's goal and the ribbons on the cup were the green and white ones: Rangers went home disappointed, but not dissatisfied with the season as a whole.

Our record in Europe was undistinguished. Aberdeen went out at the first hurdle, and Celtic, Dundee United and Rangers at the second, though all the results were close. It was left to Hearts to cover themselves with glory, reaching the quarter-finals and very nearly shocking Bayern Munich.

On the international front, Andy Roxburgh and his team enjoyed a magnificent start to their World Cup qualifying campaign. With Mo Johnston regularly scoring goals (there have been problems in this department before now) and with the squad doing well together, and turning in some excellent performances – notably against France, Scotland has reached a commanding position in the group, and we must now be hopeful of reaching the final stages. It is not a time for relaxing or over-confidence: but there seems little chance of that with the competent and thoughtful leadership, and with a great deal of planning and commitment from the management and players. The senior season ended with two somewhat irrelevant games, though doubtless useful in the way of experience. Against England a pretty weak Scottish side, which contained players who barely looked of international class on the occasion, lost to a weakened England side; this performance was redeemed by a good win against Chile, where the attendance was an all time low for an international fixture.

As a final curtain to the season came the FIFA Under 16 World Cup. This proved to be very popular with the fans – not least because of the magnificent achievement of our youngsters in reaching the final. Fancied teams came from the Middle East and Africa, as well as the recent finalists from the European competition, Portugal and East Germany. Brazil, too, could never be counted out. Scotland went from strength to strength: in a memorable final, they were leading 2-0 at half-time; but they had given their all, and the Saudi Arabians were able to level the score, and in the end win on penalties 5-4. The standard of play throughout the tournament was high, and the level of skill indicates the shape of things to come. A crowd of nearly 30,000 saw Scotland's semi-final win at Tynecastle; Motherwell, who hosted one of the groups and who had drawn substantial and enthusiastic crowds, were rewarded when FIFA moved the other semi-final there from Hampden. There were over 50,000 at Hampden for the final: there was a crowd limit, and it was a real family day. In addition to a high standard of play and sportsmanship, it was pleasant for both the SFA and the police to receive glowing compliments from FIFA for the organisation, crowd behaviour and crowd control. Congratulations to all concerned, and in particular to Craig Brown and his youth team who all did so well.
