

NOTES:

1. Not sure about the appearances of Willy and Werner Quipor of Gent as the source did not differentiate. The same applies for Johan and Dirk Dierickx of Aalst (in fewer cases and especially at the first round) and Ronny and Dirk Claes of Racing Mechelen (in two or three cases). Especially for twins Quipor, it is absolutely vague in most games which of the two is playing since either only the surname is indicated in the source or the W. Quipor (yes, thank you, big help!!!)
2. At 20th round, at the starting line up of Berchem, 10 players are indicated in the source instead of 11. Therefore the total starting line up sum of appearances is 329 instead of 330.
3. Berchem and Tongeren used the fewer players (16) while Gent used, at the other extreme, 26. Tongeren used actually 13 players as Simons, Banken and Smeets were used sparingly.
4. More yellow cards for Racing Mechelen -29 and more yellow cards for an individual player -7 for Hendrik Heyt of Gent.
5. The team with more substitutions is Patro Eisden with 50 out of the possible 60 and the team with the fewer is Berchem with 22. Berchem had the fewer substitutions the previous season also.
6. Joseph Beckers of Hasselt had the biggest number of appearances as substitution -17.

8. Waterchei THOR was the undisputed champion, winner of all three periods. In the first period, with the same point (15) as Thor, was AS oostende. In the second period, Berchem was second, one point behind THOR (again with 15 points). In the third period, Gent was second, one point behind THOR (16 points). Therefore, in the playoffs the second, third, fourth and fifth placed team participated.
9. THOR had the best attack (58 goals) and best goal difference (+35).
10. Best defence by Berchem with 22 goals. Worst defence by VG Oostende with 63 conceded goals.
11. Worst attack by VG Oostende with 16 goals.
12. Patro Eisden while second the previous season, found themselves second from the bottom this season and were relegated along with VG Oostende.
